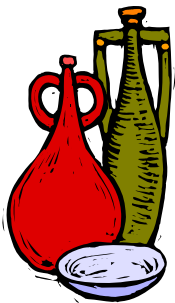

SATURDAY, April 4<sup>th</sup>, 6 to 8pm Come celebrate the end of the firing with us.

FRIDAY, APRIL 17<sup>TH</sup>, 10am Kiln opening. Come see the hard work pay off with the unloading of the kiln. There are always a few surprises! Unloading takes about 45 minutes and after we discuss the results and have a potluck luncheon. Bring your favorite dish to share.

The firing is only for those who signed up and paid for it but anyone can come to the **OPENING OF THE KILN** on the 17<sup>th</sup>.. It is fun to see what an extended process this is. Anything from potato chips to Fois de Gras is your ‘admission fee’.

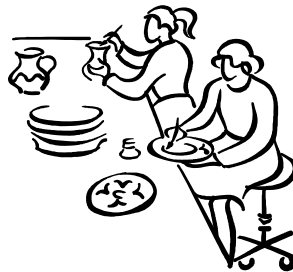
