On 11/18/23, we held our first demonstration at the Palm Beach Atlantic Univ. We were graciously hosted by Professor Heather Couch, a VERY talented ceramicist whose works you may have recently seen at the Coral Springs Museum of Art along with Thomas Stollar.

Barbara Powell shared two new techniques that she learned from a workshop with Akira Satake (<https://akirasatake.com>). The first was a one-piece tea bowl with a kohiki slip and the second was using a kurinuki technique (starting from a solid form).

Kohiki Slip Recipe

Cone 04-6

- Kaolin - 35
- Gold Art - 30
- Nepheline Syenite - 25
- Wollastonite - 10

** Mix to the consistency of thick yogurt. Let sit overnight and apply onto a slab with a large paint brush. Once leather-hard, move the clay until it starts to crack.
