#### CERAMICS FROM DR. ROBERT AND DEANNA HARRIS BURGER COLLECTION

The following quotations are from the book *FUNCTION, FORM & FANTASY; CERAMICS from the Dr. Robert and Deanna Harris Burger Collection*, published for this exhibition at the Flint Institute of Art, in Flint, Michigan in 2016.

"Today, the Burger's reside in Florida and together have built an impressive art collection using the knowledge they have gained through studying and visiting exhibitions, galleries, studios, private collections and taking studio classes."

"Dr. Robert and Deanna Harris Burger have been collecting contemporary ceramic works of art since the 1970's. They were inspired by the beautiful forms, colors and innovative techniques used to create the works."

"For the Burgers, understanding technique is important but so is learning the latest trends and news about ceramics. To keep current, they attend the National Council on Education for the Ceramic Arts (NCECA) every year to "see what is coming up and what's happening." At NCECA, the Burgers often buy directly from the artist, rounding out their collection of established works with pieces by young and up-and-coming artists."

"After getting to know the Burgers, you quickly understand that what they collect is also a reflection of who they are: creative, imaginative, and most of all, unique. As caretakers, Bob and Debbie have provided an excellent model for us all, for they not only care for the art, seeing to its safety and display, but they also care enough to share their passion with us."
