The Artists of Palm Beach County presents "Fired and Fabricated: A Collaboration of the Palm Beach Modern Quilt Guild and the Ceramic League of the Palm Beaches" at the HATCH 1121 Gallery in Lake Worth

Coiled, thrown, and slab-built ceramic pieces and sculptures are shown next to hand-stitched and machined quilts. exploring an array of color and form ranging from realistic to abstract. The show was curated by Heather Couch, Dr. Nazaré Feliciano, and Virginia Walton. Feliciano, an internationally renowned ceramic artist, comments, "The juxtaposition of the soft fabrics engaging visually with the ceramic sculpture is unique and scintillating."
